

On this date I responded to a two vehicle non-injury accident on Us Hwy 60 at I-49 overpass. Upon my arrival I made contact with a Mr. Robert G Taylor who is identified in this report as driver one of vehicle one.

Driver one reported the driver of vehicle two was running late for work and did provide him with his name and place of employment. Driver one said he was approaching the intersection and was slowing to stop for a red light, when he signaled to change lanes. Driver one said he looked to see if any vehicles were in the outside lane before making the lane change to the #02 outside lane.

Driver one said as he proceeded to change lanes, he was struck by vehicle two in the right front wheel and fender area. Driver one said he did not see vehicle two and did not know where he had come from.

Driver one declined medical treatment at the scene and his vehicle was drivable from the scene. Vehicle one had right front fender and bumper damage, which is consistent with his statement.

Driver one said the driver of vehicle two informed him he did not have a license and did not have insurance information on the vehicle. Driver one said he obtained drivers two's name and wrote his license plate down before he left the scene.

Driver two was later identified by Joplin Police Officer Rivers at his place of employment. Driver two was identified as Mr. Jimmy A Cubias. Officer Rivers provided me with a phone number of his place of employment. I later contacted Driver two who had to use a translator to communicate with me due to a language barrier.

Driver two said he was on his way to work, traveling East on Us Hwy 60 and was approaching the red light in the outside #02 lane when vehicle one made a lane change and struck his vehicle in or near the driver's door. Driver two stated he was late for work and provided Driver one with his name and place of employment and then left.

Both vehicles were removed from the roadway prior to by arrival and no measurements were obtained.
