





**MAIN NARRATIVE**

On 10/24/2014 at approximately 17:27 hours, I was dispatched to the 800 block of Spencer Drive to take a report of a traffic accident.

When I arrived on scene to 814 Spencer Drive I observed one vehicle was involved. The vehicle was a 2004 KIA Sorento sports utility vehicle bearing Missouri PM7F9V. The vehicle was being driven by Alyssa Stuart. The rear of the vehicle was backed up against a tree in the front yard of the residence.

I made contact with Ms. Stuart. Miss Stuart was disoriented and unsure of what just occurred. She stated she was at the intersection of West South Street and Spencer Drive facing north. She stated she was on her way to see her boyfriend. She advised she passed out and next thing she knew was she was sitting in a yard against a tree.

I spoke to a neighbor, who wanted to remain anonymous. He stated he was standing outside of his house when he saw the vehicle slowly cross the intersection heading north, drive through the yard at 814 Spencer Drive, then cross into the neighbors yard at 813 and hit a tree head on. He stated it bounced off of it and rolled backward into 815's yard and come to a rest against another tree. He stated it appeared as though she was passed out.

I observed there to be parts of her bumper next to the neighbor's tree and some bark missing off of the tree. There appeared to be very little damage to the tree she rolled into. There was significant damage to the front end of her vehicle and both airbags deployed.

Ms. Stuart had marks on her body that are common with seatbelt use. The Newton County ambulance checked her out due to her stating she had a pain in her stomach. It was determined the possible cause for her to black out was due to dehydration. The owners of the tree did not want a report for damage to their tree. Ms. Stuart's vehicle was towed due to disabling damage by Poore's Towing.
