



On December 29, 2014, I responded to Neosho Boulevard and Harmony Street for a report of a non injury traffic collision.

While in route I was informed that both parties had moved their vehicles to the parking lot of Southwest Missouri Bank. I arrived on scene and spoke with Mr. Hoyt Hines, identified by his Missouri driver's license. He was the driver of a white in color 1999 Chevrolet Silverado, with a Missouri registration of 8FC544. I later labeled Mr. Hines truck as vehicle 1 in this report. He said he was traveling south on Neosho Boulevard and had moved over into the right turn lane to turn west on Harmony Street. He said he had to stop behind vehicle 2, who was stopped to yield for traffic. Mr. Hines said his foot slipped off the brake pedal and he rolled forward and struck vehicle 2 in the rear bumper and his tow hooks punctured two holes in the rear bumper cover of vehicle 2. Mr. Hines provided valid proof of insurance for his vehicle.

Vehicle 2 was a yellow in color 2005 Chevrolet Aveo, with a Missouri temporary registration of 00M9MK. It was being driven by Brian Culley, who was identified by his Missouri driver's license. He stated he was traveling south on Neosho Boulevard and moved over to make a right hand turn onto Harmony Street. He said he had to yield to oncoming traffic and came to a stop. He said he was soon struck from behind by vehicle 1. He said they made contact and agreed to move the vehicles from the roadway.

Vehicle 2 was occupied by a female passenger in the front seat, who was identified by her Missouri driver's license as Sheyla Johnson. She was the owner of the car and provided valid proof of insurance. Nobody reported being injured as a result of the collision.

I checked the damage to both vehicles and determined vehicle 1 had not been damaged. Vehicle 2 had two holes in the rear bumper cover that matched the shape and size of the tow hooks on the front of vehicle 1.

Upon completion of my investigation it appears that vehicle 1 was stopped with a short distance of vehicle 2 at the intersection. It appeared Mr. Hines did not allow adequate room to stop if needed and was too close to vehicle 2.
