

On Friday, February 20, 2015 at approximately 2054 hours, I responded to the intersection of Lusk Drive and Industrial Drive in reference to a traffic crash. I arrived on scene and observed a vehicle that had been overturned and was lying on its hood in the parking lot of A1 Affordable Auto Parts. There were several individuals standing around the vehicle and when asked none stated they observed the traffic crash occur.

I made contact with a female subject and identified her as Cassie Cash and driver 1. Ms. Cash was crying and was very hysterical when I made contact with her. She had a few scratches on her face and dried blood on her hands. I asked Ms. Cash if she was injured and she said she was not and did not need medical attention. Ms. Cash signed a refusal to be transported to the hospital by ambulance but was checked out by paramedics on scene and was medically cleared.

Ms. Cash said she drove out of the parking lot of Wal-Mart on Lusk Drive and came to the intersection of Industrial Drive. She said she turned east onto Industrial very quickly and her car began to fishtail. She said she tried to correct the fishtail but lost control of her vehicle and went into the ditch in front of A1 Affordable Auto Parts. She said her front left tire hit the curb and her car flipped; landing on its hood.

It is to be noted while speaking with Ms. Cash I could smell a strong odor of intoxicants coming from her person.

I made contact with Ms. Cash's boyfriend, Toosie Mcanally. Mr. Mcanally stated he was driving in a separate vehicle and observed the crash happen. Mr. Mcanally's explanation of what happened during the crash matched what Ms. Cash had stated.

The damage to the vehicle coincided with the statements from driver 1 and the witness. The vehicle was towed from the scene by Ron's towing due to disabling damage. I took pictures of the vehicle and have attached them to this report.

I have nothing further at this time.
