

On 02/26/2015 at 07:52 hours, I responded to the intersection of Highway 59 and Industrial Drive to take a report of a traffic accident.

When I arrived on scene I observed two vehicles were involved. Vehicle one was a White Hyundai bearing Missouri WH4Z7A. Vehicle two was a black Chevrolet pickup bearing Missouri 1MR651. Vehicle one was driven by Catherine Fieker. Vehicle two was driven by Gregory Skinner.

I spoke to Ms. Fieker. She was visibly shaken up but advised she was not injured. She stated she was turning left onto Industrial Drive from Highway 59 to head to work. She stated she didn't know if she had the red light or the green light. Her vehicle sustained damage to the passenger side but was able to drive from the scene.

After speaking with her, I spoke with Mr. Skinner. He stated he was sitting at the stop light and started driving through the intersection when the light changed to green. He stated vehicle one came "zipping through the intersection via the turn lane", causing him to drive into the passenger side of her vehicle. He stated he spoke to a witness and provided me with her information. Her information is listed in the person's page of this report. He stated he was not injured. His vehicle was able to drive from the scene and sustained damage to the front end.

The witness, Monica Blain, stated Ms. Blain stated vehicle two was stopped at the light and started going through the intersection when it turned green. She stated vehicle one came through the intersection from the turn lane and was struck by vehicle two.

It should be noted it was snowing out but was not stuck to the ground. The wind chill was below zero with a very strong wind.
