

On Friday, April 10, 2015 at approximately 2005 hours, Sergeant Fienen and I reported to North Lincoln Street south of Grant Street in reference to an accident. Upon arriving on scene, I discovered a silver pick-up truck in the creek on the east side of North Lincoln Street approximately 300 feet south of Grant Street. There was no one near the truck at the time of my arrival. Upon first inspection of the truck, Sgt. Fienen discovered what appeared to be a 9mm handgun in the floorboard of the driver's side. The firearm was taken out of the vehicle, made safe, and secured in the back of my patrol car.

I was contacted by a male subject, later identified as Darrell Osborn, who was waiting in his truck several feet up the road. Mr. Osborn said his girlfriend, later identified as Janet Galbraith, called him and told him she had driven off the road and was stuck in the ditch. He said he told her to wait there and he would come pick her up. Mr. Osborn said when he arrived on scene, we were already there and he did not see her anywhere. Mr. Osborn said he attempted to call Ms. Galbraith on her cell phone, but she was not answering. He said he was going to drive around and try to locate her to bring her back to the scene so she could speak with us.

I inspected the area around the vehicle. I noticed several scratches on the rocks leading up to the vehicle. I located what appeared to be the beginning of the scratch marks approximately 50 feet south of where the vehicle was currently located. This spot appeared to be where the vehicle first left the road way. There was no damage to any property, there were only a few broken rocks.

Poore's Salvage arrived on scene and attempted to remove the vehicle from the creek. Dickson Towing also arrived on scene to assist in lifting the truck out of the creek and back onto the road. Once out of the creek, Sgt. Fienen and I briefly checked the vehicle for evidence of whom it may belong to. Several items were located in the truck, including a driver's license for Ms. Galbraith. The vehicle was towed by Poore's Salvage.

I attempted to make contact with Ms. Galbraith but was unsuccessful. Mr. Osborn said Ms. Galbraith had moved from the address we had for her on file, but he was not sure where she moved to. I went by the address we had on file and there was no answer. The apartment did appear to be empty. I also called Freeman in Neosho and they informed me that had not had any patients under that name all night. One of the items located in the truck was cell phone that belonged to Ms. Galbraith. The number for that cell phone is the only number we have on file for her.

I have nothing further at this time.
