



On 08/25/2015 I responded to the intersection of South Neosho Boulevard and West South Street to take a report of a traffic crash.

I arrived at the intersection of South Neosho Boulevard and West South Street. I first saw a silver 2015 Ford Escape displaying North Carolina registration (CMB4979 [V2]) in the intersection facing east. I walked up to the vehicle and noticed a maroon 2003 Chrysler Town and Country displaying Missouri registration (DL8X7N [V1]) facing south in the intersection.

I saw damage to the front end of the Chrysler and damage to the driver side door of the Ford. The front end of the Chrysler appeared to be stuck underneath the driver side of the Ford. I asked the driver of the Ford (Terri Nighswonger [D2]) if she was injured. She stated she was not. She said she could not get out of her driver side door. While I was writing down information from Ms. Nighswonger she was able to crawl out of the passenger side door. She stepped out of the vehicle and appeared to be uninjured.

I spoke with the driver of the Chrysler (Tonya Bridges [D1]). I asked if she was injured. She stated she was not. She was standing outside of her vehicle; there were no apparent injuries to her body. I asked Ms. Bridges what happened. She stated she thought she ran a red light.

I spoke with a witness (Nicki Lawson) who stated she was behind D1. Ms. Lawson said the light was red when Ms. Bridges attempted to drive right through the intersection. Ms. Lawson said she thought Ms. Nighswonger's vehicle was going to flip over due to the high velocity of the impact.

Ofc. Schlessman spoke with two other witnesses (Dillion Hamilton and Sean Sides) who were parked in the turn lane next to Ms. Bridges. They confirmed that Ms. Bridges ran a red light. I exchanged both drivers information.

Poore's Towing arrived to transport V1. Ms. Bridges was able to move her vehicle and drive away without it needing towed though the damage sustained appeared to be disabling. Poore's Towing towed V2 to Buhr's Auto Body.

Measurements were not taken due to heavy traffic flow.
