

Officers responded to a crash at Neosho Blvd and South Street. From this investigation it was determined that one vehicle was traveling south on Neosho Blvd (Vehicle 1) and one was traveling east on South Street (Vehicle 2.) This intersection was under maintenance and the light here was flashing four-way red.

Vehicle 1 was driven by John Frossard. Mr. Frossard stated he stopped at the intersection before continuing southbound. He stated he thought he had the right of way but was not sure. He said he didn't notice vehicle 2 enter the intersection. Both parties in vehicle 1 refused the need for medical treatment and vehicle 2 was not damage enough to require tow.

Vehicle 2 was driven by Sharon Hines. She reported she stopped at the light before proceeding into the intersection. She stated she was struck by vehicle 1 as she tried to make a left turn. Ms. Hines said there was a lot of confusion due to the lights not working and she was unsure exactly who had the right-of-way. Ms. Hines reported she was not injured and her vehicle did not require tow.

Vehicle 1 had entered the intersection after vehicle 2; this being determined by the location of damage. Vehicle 2 was impacted in the left rear and vehicle 1 impacted vehicle 2 at the front and front left.
